ORDINANCE NO. 23-_____

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A NUISANCE STRUCTURE ON CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED IN ROGERS, ARKANSAS; ORDERING THE RAZING AND REMOVAL OF SAID STRUCTURE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, LJ Remainder, LLC is the owner of certain real property situated in Rogers, Benton County, Arkansas, more particularly described as follows:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: Part of the NW1/4 of the SW1/4 of Section 12, Township 19 North, Range 30 West, described as beginning at the NE corner of said NW1/4 of the SW1/4 and running thence South 178.57 feet; thence North 87°56' West 150 feet; thence North to the North line of the said NW1/4 of the SW1/4; thence East along the North line of said NW1/4 of the SW1/4 to the place of beginning; subject to the right of way of U.S. Highway 71 on the North side thereof. Less and except: Part of the NW1/4 of the SW1/4 of Section 12, Township 19 North, Range 30 West, Benton County, Arkansas, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point being used as the Center West Sixteenth Corner of said Section 12; thence South 02°23'32" West a distance of 30.00 feet to a point on the South right of way line of U.S. Highway 71B (West Walnut Street) as established by the plat of Tract 1A of the Lot Split for Braum's of Rogers as shown on the plat recorded in Plat Book 17 at Page 118 for the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence continuing South 02°23'32" West along said right of way line a distance of 5.00 feet to a point on the West line of said tract 1A; thence continuing South 02°23'32" West along said West line a distance of 10.00 feet to a point on the South right of way line of U.S. Highway 71B (West Walnut Street) as established by AHTD Job 090338; thence North 86°42'26" West along said right of way line a distance of 149.49 feet to a point; thence North 02°16'53" East a distance of 15.00 feet to a point on the South right of way line of U.S. Highway 71B (West Walnut Street) as established AHTD Job 481; thence South 86°42'26" East along said right of way line a distance of 149.52 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 0.05 acres (2,243 square feet) more or less, as shown on plans referenced as AHTD Job 090338.

WHEREAS, the structure on the property is unfit for human habitation, constitutes a fire hazard, and is otherwise a dangerous to human life, or constitutes a hazard to safety or health by reason of inadequate maintenance, dilapidation, obsolescence, or abandonment, and further is unsightly, and is considered an unsafe and unsightly structure in violation of City of Rogers' Code of Ordinance, Sections 18-55 through 18-68; more specifically, the following violations have been found to exist:

- 1. 2012 IPMC - §301.3 - Vacant structures and land.** All vacant structures and premises thereof or vacant land shall be maintained in a clean, safe, secure and sanitary condition as provided herein so as not to cause a blighting problem or adversely affect the public health or safety.

2. **2012 IPMC - §304.2 - Protective treatment.** All exterior surfaces, including but not limited to, doors, door and window frames, cornices, porches, trim, balconies, decks and fences, shall be maintained in good condition. Exterior wood surfaces, other than decay-resistant woods, shall be protected from the elements and decay by painting or other protective covering or treatment. Peeling, flaking and chipped paint shall be eliminated and surfaces repainted. All siding and masonry joints, as well as those between the building envelope and the perimeter of windows, doors and skylights, shall be maintained weather resistant and water tight. All metal surfaces subject to rust or corrosion shall be coated to inhibit such rust and corrosion, and all surfaces with rust or corrosion shall be stabilized and coated to inhibit future rust and corrosion. Oxidation stains shall be removed from exterior surfaces. Surfaces designed for stabilization by oxidation are exempt from this requirement.
3. **2012 IMPC – §304.6 – Exterior walls:** All exterior walls shall be free from holes, breaks, and loose or rotting materials; and maintained weatherproof and properly surface coated where required to prevent deterioration.
4. **2012 IMPC – §304.7 - Roofs and drainage.** The roof and flashing shall be sound, tight and not have defects that admit rain. Roof drainage shall be adequate to prevent dampness or *deterioration* in the walls or interior portion of the structure. Roof drains, gutters and downspouts shall be maintained in good repair and free from obstructions. Roof water shall not be discharged in a manner that creates a public nuisance.

WHEREAS, the owners were given proper notice of numerous violations of the standards provided for in the Rogers’ Code of Ordinances, including the International Property Maintenance Code (“IPMC”) as adopted by reference in Rogers’ Code of Ordinances §§ 10-32 and 10-33, which constitute life, health, or safety violations, located on the property described above, and were instructed to abate the nuisance in accordance with § 18-58 of the Code of Ordinances;

WHEREAS, pursuant to City of Rogers Code of Ordinances Section 18-59(d); a follow up compliance inspection was conducted by the Office of Building Inspections on August 10, 2023, which concluded that violations currently exist, the structure constitutes a hazard to health and safety, and the structure requires condemnation and razing to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the public;

WHEREAS, the owner has failed, neglected, or refused to comply with the Notice to correct the documented violations, and as such, the matter of condemning, razing, and removing the building may be referred to the Rogers City Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 14-56-203, if repair or removal is not done within the required time frame, the City shall have the power to order the removal or razing of, or to remove or raze any buildings that in the opinion of the Council have become dilapidated, unsightly, unsafe, unsanitary, obnoxious, or detrimental to the public welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROGERS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: The structure located at 1108 W. Walnut St, Rogers, Arkansas, is dilapidated, unsightly, and unsafe; and it is in the best interest of the City of Rogers to proceed with the removal of this dilapidated, unsightly, and unsafe structure;

Section 2: That the owner is hereby ordered to raze (demolish) and remove the dilapidated, unsightly, and unsafe structure located on the aforesaid property; and, is further ordered to abate the unsightly conditions on the property. Said work shall be completed within thirty (30) days from the passage of this ordinance. The manner of razing (demolishing) and removing said structure shall be to dismantle by hand or bulldoze and then dispose of all debris, completely cleaning up the property to alleviate any unsightly conditions, in a manner consistent with City of Rogers' Code of Ordinances Chapters 10, 18, and 20, and all other state laws and regulations pertaining to the demolition or removal of residential structures;

Section 3: If the aforesaid work is not completed within thirty (30) days, the Mayor, or the Mayor's authorized representative, is hereby directed to cause the aforesaid structure to be razed (demolished) and removed; and the unsafe, unsanitary and unsightly conditions abated; and the City of Rogers shall have a lien upon the aforesaid described real property for the cost of razing (demolishing) and removing said structure and abating said aforementioned conditions, said costs to be determined at a hearing before the City Council;

Section 4: Emergency Clause: The need to raze and remove a certain structure is immediate and in order to protect the public peace, health, safety and welfare an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval;

Section 5: Severability Provision: If any part of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in effect as if such invalid portion never existed; and

Section 6: Repeal of Conflicting Resolutions: All Ordinances, Resolutions, or Orders of the City Council, or parts of the same, in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

WHEREAS, the owners were given proper notice of numerous violations of the standards provided for in the Rogers’ Code of Ordinances, including the International Property Maintenance Code (“IPMC”) as adopted by reference in Rogers’ Code of Ordinances §§ 10-32 and 10-33, which constitute life, health, or safety violations, located on the property described above, and were instructed to abate the nuisance in accordance with § 18-58 of the Code of Ordinances;

Section 1: A hearing to determine if the structure shall be deemed a nuisance is scheduled for and shall be held along with the regularly scheduled City Council meeting on Tuesday, September 26th, 2023 at 6:30 p.m.;

Section 2: The City’s Legal Department will send a copy of this Resolution and its request for clean-up costs to the property owner as required under Ark. Code Ann. § 14-54-903;

Section 3: Severability Provision: If any part of this Resolution is held to be invalid, the remainder of this Resolution shall continue in effect as if such invalid portion never existed; and

Section 4: Repeal of Conflicting Resolutions: All Ordinances, Resolutions, or Orders of the City Council, or parts of the same, in conflict with this Resolution are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

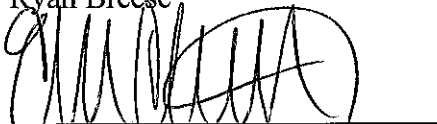
